F. Social Ills of Pornography an Aspect of Other Spheres

The social maladies of pornography abounds and some of them are as follows:

- 1. Social Isolation: This will give rise to withdrawal from social activities, developing secret life, lying, deceit, self-centeredness, choosing porn over people etc.
- 2. Mood Disorder: There is a feeling of irritability, anger, depression, mood swings, pervasive anxiety, fearfulness, feeling powerless in relation to porn etc.
- 3. Sexually Objectifying Other People: This will trigger treating people as sex objects, judging people primarily based on their body parts, disrespecting other people's needs for privacy and safety, being insensitive about sexually harmful behaviour etc.
- 4. Engaging in Risky and Dangerous Behaviours: These are accessing porn at work or school, accessing child abuse imagery, participating in degrading, abusive, violent or criminal sexual activity, producing, selling and distributing porn, engaging in physically unsafe and harmful sex etc.
- 5. Unhappy Intimate Partner: With pornography, relationship is marred by dishonesty, deception, anger etc. partner views porn as infidelity i.e. cheating. Relationship decays due to lack of trust and respect. Partner feel sexually threatened by the porn and they lose emotional closeness and mutual sexual enjoyment.
- 6. Sexual Problems: Pornography will make one lose interest in sex with a real partner, experience difficulty becoming aroused or achieving orgasm without porn, intrusive thoughts, fantasies and having images of porn during sex, becoming sexually demanding and rough in sex, having difficulty contending love and caring with sex, feeling sexually out of control and compulsive, growing with dissatisfaction with sex, increased interest in risky, degrading, abusive, illegal sex. They experience sexual dysfunction like inability to orgasm, delayed ejaculation and erectile dysfunction.
- 7. Self Loathing: This manifest by feeling disconnected from personal values, beliefs and goals. There is loss of personal integrity, damaged self-esteem, persistent feelings of guilt and shame or feelings controlled by porn.
